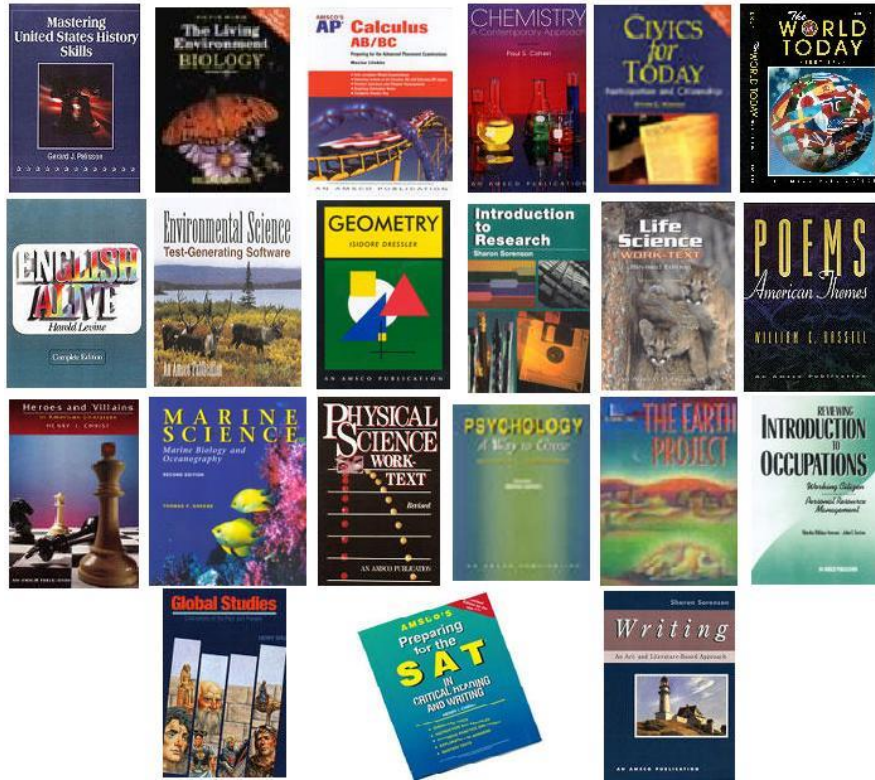


MALIBU COVE HIGH SCHOOL CURRICULUM SAMPLES

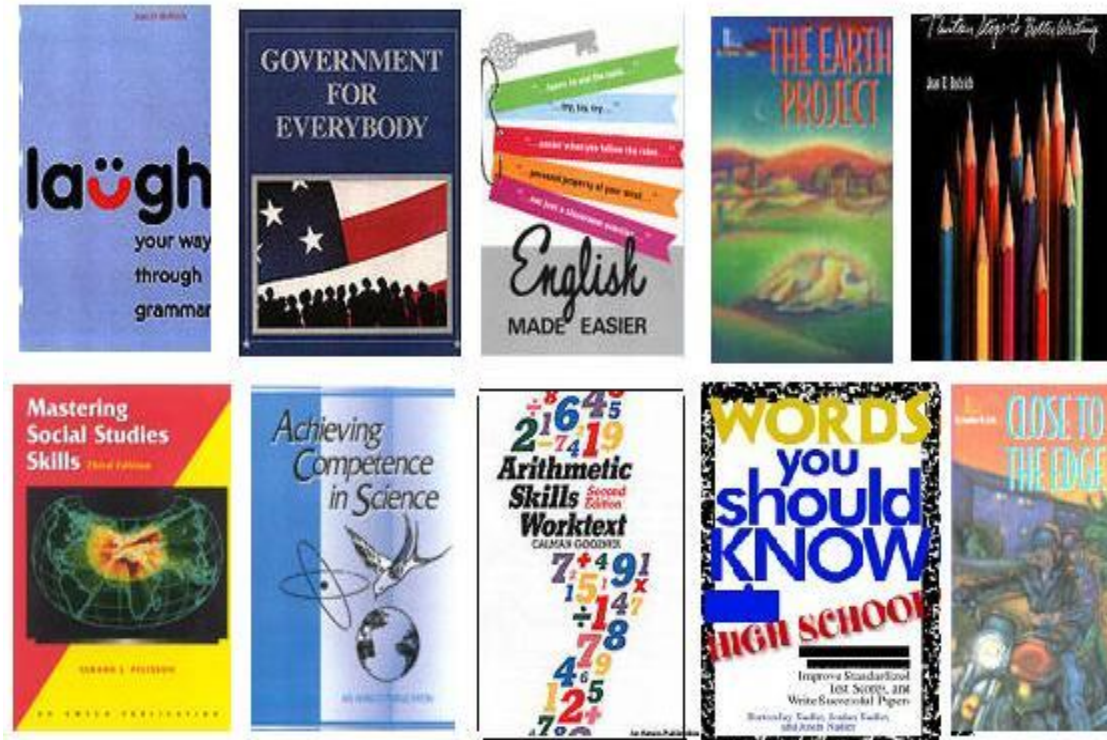
GRADES 9TH THROUGH 12TH

REMEDIAL PROGRAM:



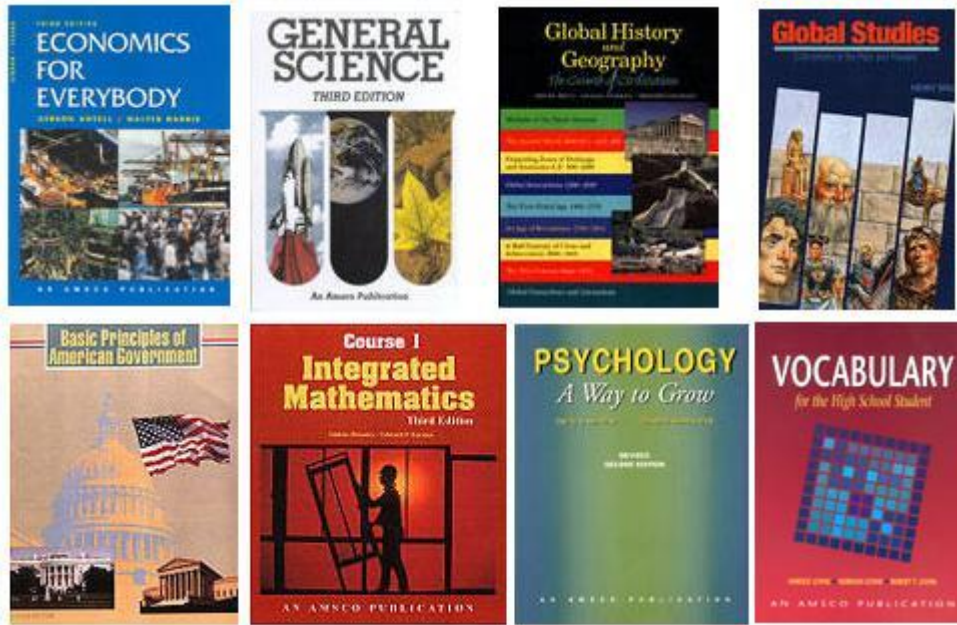
The Malibu Cove High School Remediation Program ensures you learn - and master - the skills that you need to catch up with peers. This program primarily focuses on preventing you from falling too far behind in high school when the skill gap becomes too intense. This program offers many different opportunities to supplement, support, and manage a child's learning, particularly those considered at-risk.

In addition to individualized curriculum, the pace and process of the program is also customized. An average class takes about 120 hours to finish but students work at their own pace and on their own time. Students wishing to give more time to a particular subject can take longer while those comfortable in a subject can move forward at an accelerated pace. Students and parents also have access to instructors and can email at any time with questions or concerns

ACCELERATED PROGRAM



The MCHS Accelerated Program includes all required subjects that have not been previously taken. It allows students at least 16 years of age to complete all high school requirements and graduate within 9 months. The program can be completed within 6 months to one year depending on how quickly the student masters the materials and completes the assignments. An accredited High School Diploma will be conferred once all coursework is complete, all subjects passed and tuition is paid in full.

With Malibu Cove High School's Accelerated Program, students work at their own pace anytime, anywhere. They will utilize learning styles that favor workbooks and texts that have the same prescriptive opportunities by nationally standardized textbook materials. Students are assigned to an Academic Advisor who grades all completed assignments and issues progress reports throughout the program. While working through the program, access to the student's Academic Advisor is available via email five days a week, from 8:00am to 5:00pm PST.
